The Hanoverian Metallers
return with another hammer blow.

Seven years have passed since "Unbroken" and now the Hanoverian Metallers return with another hammer blow. "III" starts with a powerful, no-frills metal number called 'Rise' that clearly sets the direction for the next forty minutes: energetic and uncompromising. Back in the line up is original singer Jürgen Wulfes. With him also the rawness and unpolishedness returns to the vocals and enhances the compositions. For the most part, initiator, guitarist and namesake René Thomsen is responsible for these. His visions of hard metal music are once again implemented at a high level and sound-technically refined by Charlie Bauerfeind. Thomsen, who convincingly takes over the vocals himself for the first time in 'Turn On The Light' (which is followed by an original Hiddentrack), is supported by guitarist Michael Pesin, Niklas Turmann on bass and Michael Kolar on drums. After the somewhat weaker predecessor, Thomsen show that they are back on track and celebrate their passion: straightforward heavy metal.
